Mini/Junior/Youth

To all young rugby players and their parents, welcome to Macclesfield Rugby Club. If you were previously members last season congratulations on what was undoubtedly a successful season, if you are joining us for the 1st time, congratulations on becoming a member of Cheshire's Premier Junior Rugby Club.

For all minis and juniors, training officially begins at 10.30am each Sunday except on match days when each coach will inform their squads what time to be present. Please find within the welcome pack a copy of this season's fixtures.

Occasionally, matches will be cancelled and additional matches/tournaments will be organised. Your child's coach will give you details of these during the season or keep your eye on your teams pages on the club website

Youth Rugby encompasses the age groups from under 16 to 19 years within three teams, Under 16, Junior Colts [U17] Senior Colts [U19 - two years]. Under 16's continue their development with games and training on Sunday mornings throughout the season. The Junior and Senior Colts play on Sunday afternoons in the Raging Bull Colts League and are seeded in the 'A' Leagues. Details of the League can be found at www.colts-rugby.org.uk. In addition to playing league games every Sunday during the season we complete in League/County and National Cup Competitions. Training takes place on mid week and details can be found via the Coaches/Managers.

Players will also be developed to play for the Clubs Senior sides, County Squads and England representative teams.

Coaches

We have a full set of qualified coaches for all age groups. Most squads will have at least two coaches to develop the players' skills and abilities. We are always looking for more coaches to join our enthusiastic team of volunteers and the club, subject to agreement by the relevant section Chairman's, will reimburse all course fees to obtain the necessary qualification. Most importantly all coaches have been screened (Criminal Records Bureau checked) for their suitability for working with young people.

Annual Subscriptions

As previously we must insist on a "no pay no play" policy, for insurance purposes. Therefore, please return your completed MRUFC registration form A.S.A.P., to allow the players the opportunity to play and progress their rugby.

All registered mini/junior players receive complimentary access to all Macclesfield First Team (The Blues) home matches, so come along on Saturdays to support your future team!

Child protection and expectations of parents/guardians, coaches and players

In accordance with the RFU's child protection scheme, Macclesfield RUFC has a child protection policy and a Child Protection Officer – Mr. Mark Sharples. Details are posted on the Club notice board. There are certain expectations of players and coaches in addition to parents/guardians. I have attached our codes of conduct for coaches, parents/guardians and our Junior club rules and I would ask that you familiarise yourselves with these in order to ensure the safety and well-being of all young players.

In addition to these codes of conduct and Junior rules, I have noted some important points for parents/guardians below:

- In order for the coaches to develop their squads, **no child should be left without a responsible adult in attendance** – the club will have coffee/tea and bacon rolls available on Sunday mornings, so why not come for breakfast while your child is tearing up the pitch?

- All players must be officially registered at the age of 6 on the 1st Sept. Please check with Bev Roberts in the Club office if you are unsure about any registration issues.
- All players must have the correct and appropriate clothing (waterproofs, warm tops, track suit bottoms, studded boots etc) and **protection (gum shields)**. Please visit the online shop on the Club website www.maccrugby.o.uk and follow the link

If you have any concerns regarding your child's development please do not hesitate to contact the coach, the child protection officer or myself.

Clubhouse Rules

We would ask all players to remove muddy kit and boots before entering the clubhouse and make use of the changing and washing facilities in the changing rooms before going upstairs. The Club would like all to enjoy the facilities but we would kindly ask everybody to help us maintain and respect the rooms as they are used for functions during the season. Please adhere to the rules laid down with regards to this (please see posters displayed around the Club).

Social Events

We are looking to hold several social events during the season, for players and for parents/guardians. These are not only enjoyable but also a great way of raising much needed financial support for the Club. Your child's coach will let you know when these events take place and we hope you will be able to join us and meet more of the Macclesfield RUFC's best supporters' club. To maintain the clubhouse in good condition and continue to utilise the facilities for a broad range of functions and host the various rugby teams, we would kindly request that the clubhouse rules below are fully respected and adhered to by all players and spectators alike:

Clubhouse Rules

- All players/coaches/officials in rugby kit and/or boots may only enter and exit the clubhouse via the changing room entrance, situated at the rear of the clubhouse.
- All players/coaches/officials must make use of the changing and washing facilities in the changing rooms before using the front entrance or the function facilities on the first floor.
- Any player/coach/official wearing muddy kit and/or boots will be refused access to the bar and function suites on the first floor.
- Any player/coach/official wearing muddy kit and/or boots, wishing to purchase refreshments will be directed to the ground floor "Scrumdown" café facilities, serviced from outside the clubhouse.
- Any spectators wearing muddy boots/footwear are advised to change before entering the club.

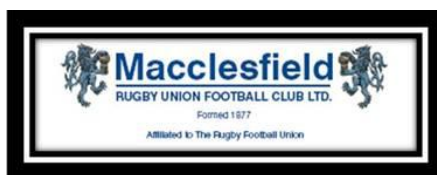
We would appreciate your cooperation and respect of the clubhouse facilities, by adhering to these basic clubhouse rules.

- All players must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.

- Players must wear suitable kit – Rugby/football boots, gum shield, rugby shirt, rugby shorts and rugby socks and weather appropriate training trousers and tops – for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Playing Members are not allowed to smoke on Club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Playing Members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.

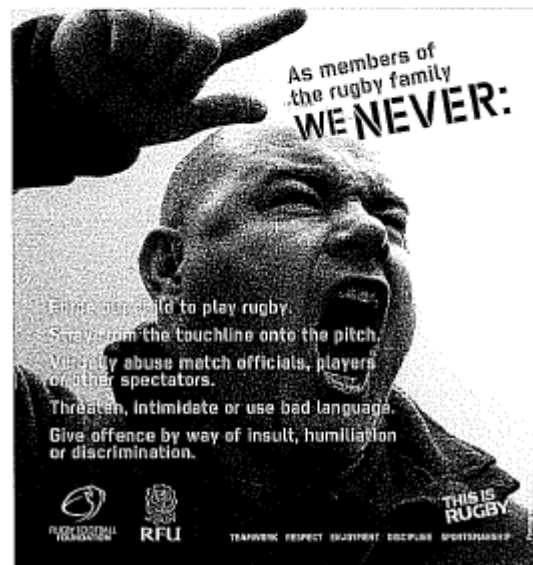
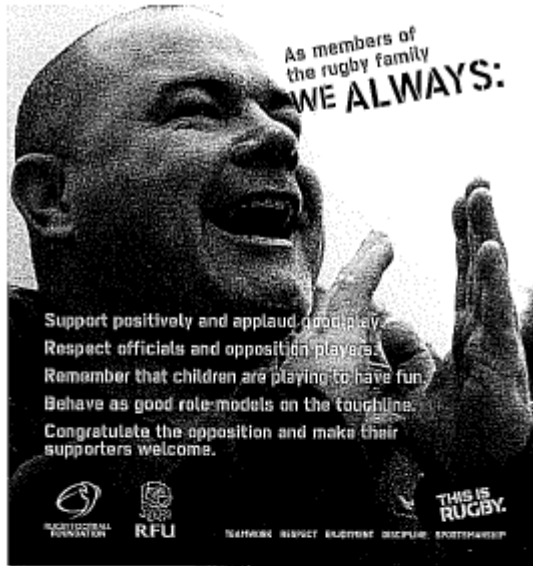
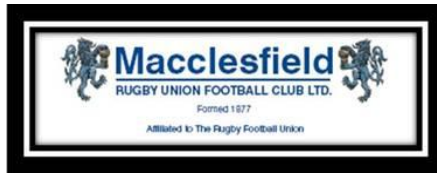
Equity policy statement

The club will deal with any incidence of discriminatory behaviour seriously, according to club disciplinary procedures.

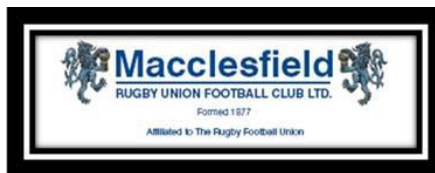


As members of the rugby family **WE ALWAYS:**

RECOMMENDED SANCTIONS FOR MEMBERS OF CLUBS INVOLVED IN OFFENCES AT MATCHES AT U18 AND BELOW

This guide is written for use by Club Disciplinary Panels when dealing with spectators/club members who offend at matches at U18 and below. It is not exhaustive and should be used in conjunction with the RFU Disciplinary Regulations, which can be found on rfu.com.

<i>For use by Club Disciplinary Panels only</i>	Suggested starting point
Entering the playing enclosure	3 weeks
Striking	6 weeks
Verbal abuse	4 weeks
Verbal abuse of match official	10 weeks
Threatening behaviour	12 weeks
Threatening behaviour towards a match official	24 weeks
Racial abuse based on religion, colour or national or ethnic origin	12 weeks
Any other act, misconduct or behaviour contrary to the spirit and/or interests of the game	6 weeks

- In assessing a penalty, Panels should take into account mitigating and/or aggravating factors which will determine a reduction or increase from the entry point.
- Clubs can, in exceptional circumstances, properly suspend wholly or in part a period of suspension.
- In the most serious cases, a life ban can be imposed.

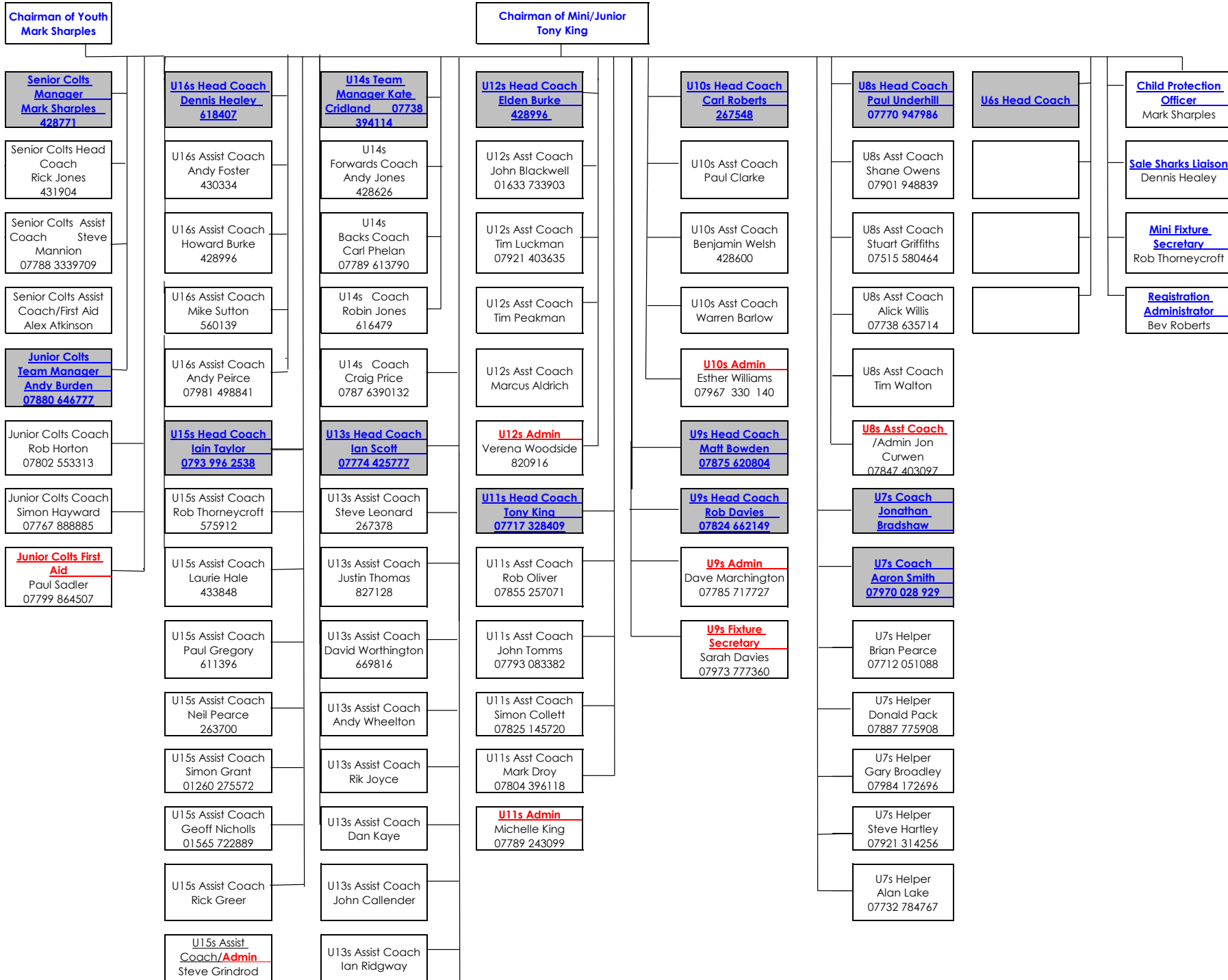

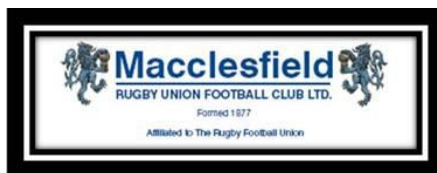
